



Worship TRIO



The programme asks the congregation to help move the parish church forward through a **series of sermon and answer Sundays**.

After each sermon the congregation is invited to give their opinions, either on a flip chart or post-it notes. The answers are collated and displayed in church throughout the programme.

These answers help form the basis for a presentation made at the end of the programme, after which information is sent to every member of the church, asking them to offer their gifts to support the work of the parish.

The programme starts with a sermon on '**Whose Responsibility Is It?**'

Then 2, 3 or 4 weekly/monthly sermon/answer services take place with the programme finishing with a presentation by three members of the congregation called '**The Responsibility Is Ours**'.

The content of the presentation comes in part from the answers received from the sermon/answer sessions.

Everyone receives in the post a letter of invitation to take part in the **TRIO** service, information and a response card, The funding team at Church House can help you to prepare these and produce stationery (at a cost).

The campaign needs input from the clergy, PCC/Steering Group and congregation.

It takes about 4 months from the start of planning to the final presentation with the sermon/answer Sundays lasting from 1-2 months.

Each **Worship TRIO** is different, meeting the individual needs of the church. It is flexible and can include house/prayer groups if required.
