What is God calling you to?

All Christians are called by God.
We are called into a relationship of love with God, which spills out into a love for all people.

We are called by the very nature of our baptism – called to be children of God.

We are called to play our part as Christians both within our church community, and within the communities of which we are a part in our everyday lives.

We may also be called to something specific at this particular point in our lives.

What could I possibly be called to?

There are people in this Diocese who:

- Hear children read in local schools
- Serve on lifeboat teams
- Bring a Christian presence to their world of work
- Offer leadership in uniformed organisations or sports teams
- Are associate members of religious communities
- Offer their knowledge or skills overseas
- Have a ministry of prayer for and with others
- Mentor troubled young adults
- Stand for election in the decision-making bodies of the church or of the local community
