



It's your call: What now?

If you want to explore further what God may be calling you to, you need to:



- Pray: take time to pray through what you're thinking and feeling. Ask others to pray for you and with you.

- Talk: go and see your vicar, talk through your sense of calling with her/him.

If you have a Local Ministry Development Team, allow the Team to know about your exploration.

You may also be encouraged to talk with a Diocesan Vocations Adviser.

- Reflect: what are the implications of your sense of calling?
What might you need to do to be better equipped to fulfil it?
Who else might you need to consult with?
